There would be no qt's and swimmers would not be disqualified. However, each club would be given a record of their swimmers who had committed stroke violations - this would ensure that the club was aware of the aspect of the stroke that should be corrected. Swimmers would have to have two times from these galas before they were eligible to swim in Grade 3. Swimmers who have competed in club open (i.e. where there are more than two clubs) galas may enter Grade 3 galas without entering the Development galas.
