**Club Youth Awards** – Clubs in Munster recognised their athletes through the MCCSA programme. This is a fine programme recognising the work young people put in separately from their achievements (e.g. medals, PPs etc) in their sport – the categories are Helping, Effort, Team Work and being a Role Model.

**Club Captains in Youth Sport** – Munster clubs contributed to this project attending workshops in Cork and Limerick. Clubs should watch out for dates for this regional training to take place. Club Captains training will take place every year on an annual basis as it will be useful for clubs to be involved to make sure the training times suit other activities on the calendar. It is aimed at 13-19 year-olds who are interested in the role of Captain or to improve their leadership skills.

**Parent Programme** – due to lack of support from Munster clubs for the parent programme workshop this event was cancelled in Autumn 2018. This is a very beneficial programme provided by Tennis Ireland to help parents understand their unique role as a sports parent. This programme will be going online later this year – more on this will be discussed at the next CCO Forum.

**CCO Forums** – two regional CCO Forums are held each year and were held in two locations each time to facilitate clubs. These forums informed clubs on compliance with the new Children First legislation - Safeguarding statement & Club Risk Assessment and also CCOs received Designated Liaison Person training which is obligatory for all CCOs to complete by Sept 2019.

The CCO Forum this quarter will be held in Limerick on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2019, in conjunction with the Munster Club Day.

**Youth Congress** – this workshop was originally a national event but last year was carried out in each region to get views from our Young People & very positive feedback was received.
