Operating Procedure for Ferryoy Swimming Club to return to training at Ferryoy Leisure Centre. 28/08/2020

(To be revised if phase's progress or regress.)

- Face coverings must be worn on entry and exit of the building.
- Hand sanitizing stations are available at all entry/exit points in the building.
- All equipment must be taken away after each session i.e. bags, water bottles, fins etc., any equipment left behind will be disposed of.
- Max allowed in male changing room is 12.
- Max allowed in female changing room is 12.
- When swimmers are using the spectator area to change they must sit and towel on the white wall. No jumping off or standing on this wall is permitted.
- Children under the age of 13 are not required to wear masks.
- Isolation room will be made available in the lifeguard station.
- Coaches are not permitted to use any staff area's while in the building.
- The maximum allowed in the building at any one time is 50 including staff.
- Specific footwear suitable for wearing on deck is encouraged.
- If for any medical reason a child requires their parent to be present please advise a staff member prior to the session.
- Markers indicating where to disrobe will be visible in the changing rooms and spectator area.
- Coaches will be allowed gain access to the building at the same time as the swimmers, while the swimmers are disrobing the coach will have this time to write up the training program. Each coach should have their own white board marker and wipe down the board once the session is finished.
