

Munster Aspiring Champions Series Round 1 Meet 1

DATES: 23 & 24 October, 2021

VENUE: University of Limerick

TIME: Saturday, Warm up from Start 10:00am

Sunday, Warm up from Start 10:00am

FEES: €3 per individual event, €10 per relay.

CLOSING DATE: All swimmers please discuss and submit entries to your coach, by Sunday 17th October

ALL SWIMMERS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH TEAM IRELAND - Age by Date 31st December, 2021

All competing clubs must provide at least one official per six swimmers per session up to a maximum of three officials per session.

CLUBS MUST NOMINATE A MAXIMUM OF TWO SCORING SWIMMERS PER EVENT WHEN SUBMITTING THEIR ENTRIES. FAILING TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN ALL SWIMMERS BEING MARKED AS "EXHIBITION". Please see below as how this should be done *

Awards:	No medals will be awarded. Team awards will be given to the top 3 highest scoring teams at each meet and most improved team between the first and second meet.
Events:	50, 100m, 200m of four strokes (Edin Form Strokes (EFS)) 200m, 400m Individual Medley 400m Freestyle Mixed 800m, 1500m Freestyle Male, Female and Mixed 1 x 50m FT & MT (10 Mays, 17M)
Entries:	No qualifying times will be published, and the meet will be open to all athletes aged 12 & over registered as competitive members. National Squad athletes will not be permitted to swim in these events. Athletes who achieve one or more qualifying standards for the Super Series may choose to enter these events in the Super Series. Swimmers may enter two events per day, but swimmers who are only swimming on one day may enter three events. Swimmers who have achieved the cut off time in an event are not eligible to swim that event.

Scoring system for Aspiring Champions Series

- Awards – prize money is to be used by the winning club to contribute towards a social event for the competing swimmers. The following awards will be presented:
 - Top three highest scoring teams (€200, €125, €75) on completion of Meet 1 and Meet 2 and the most improved team (€200) between Meet 1 and Meet2
 - Separate awards will be made for Age Group (12-16yrs) and Open (17 & over) winners (male and female combined)
 - Winning teams will receive a certificate to present on their club notice board
- Each club is allowed to nominate a maximum of two scoring entries per individual event and one scoring entry per relay event per age group.
 - Individual Events – 10/14, 15/16, 17 & over
 - Relay Events – 10-16, Open (17 & over)
- Swimmers can only score in two individual events per meet
